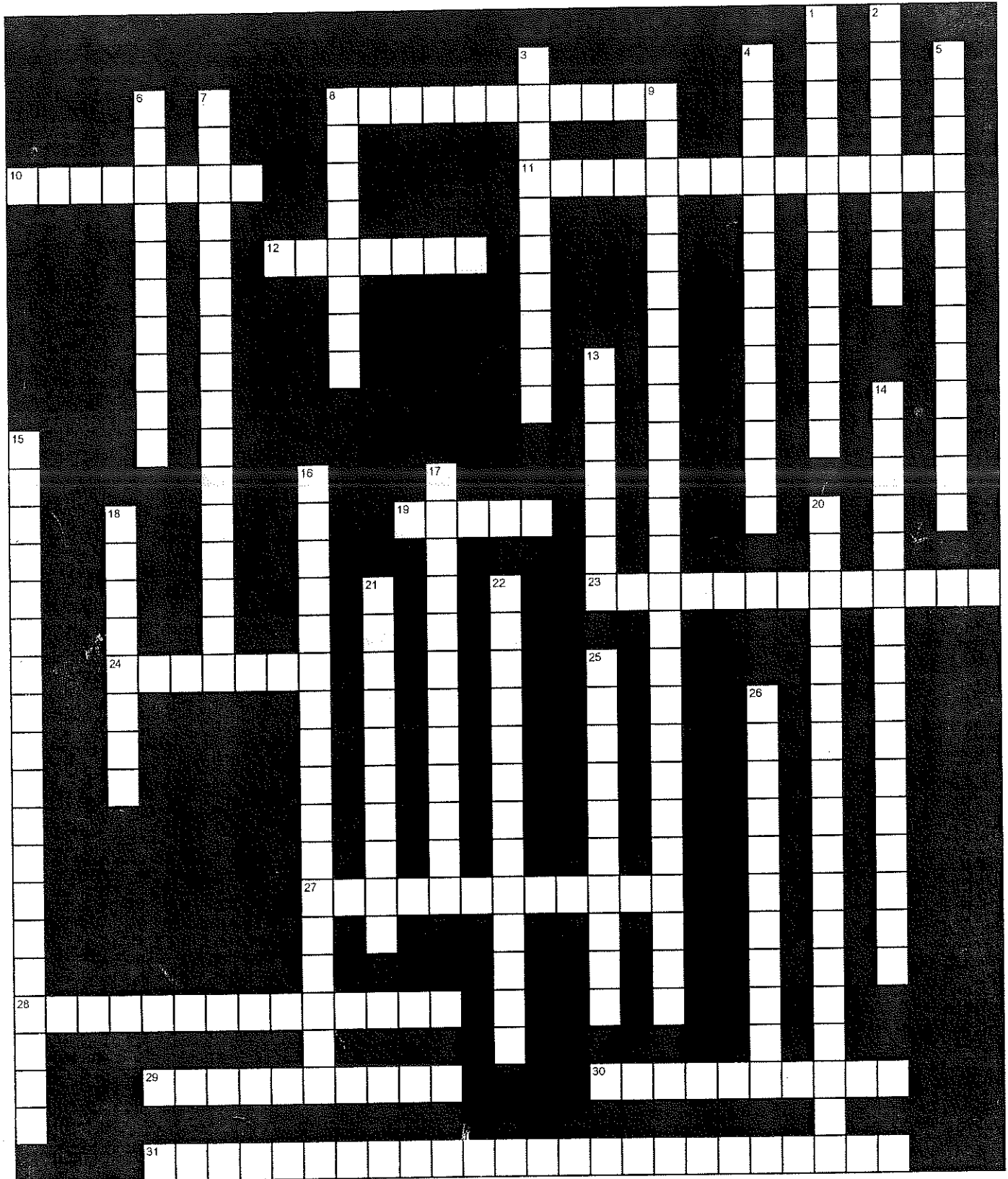

- 22 The British general in charge of the second half of the Revolutionary War
- 25 Where the battle of Bunker Hill was really fought
- 26 Where Washington and his troops spent a very difficult winter, but trained to become a better army
